

### ***I Come with Joy***

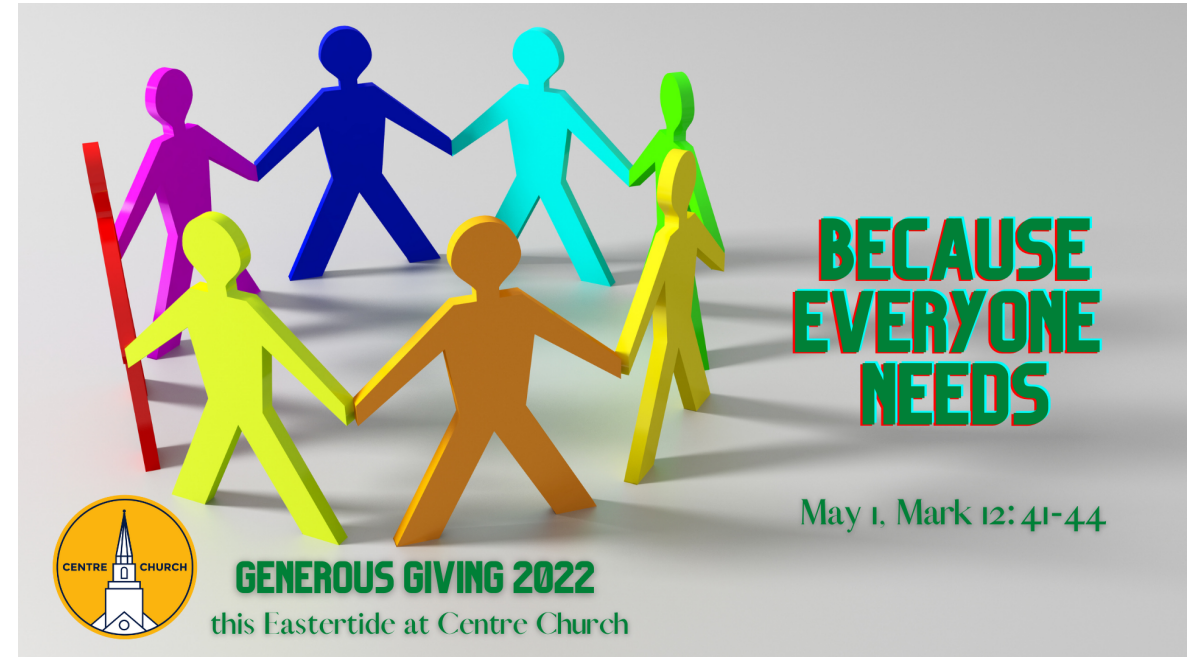
I come with joy, a child of God,

## Celebration of Baptism

### WORDS OF WELCOME

(responsively)

**LEADER:** Brothers and Sisters in Christ, we gather now to celebrate the gift of grace in the sacrament of baptism.

**PEOPLE:** **There is one body and one Spirit. There is one hope in God's call to us. There is one Lord, one faith, one baptism, one God, Creator of us all.**

**LEADER:** Baptism is the sacrament through which we are united with Jesus Christ, and given part in Christ's ministry of reconciliation. In baptism, God works in us the power of forgiveness and the renewal of the Spirit, and the knowledge of the call to be Christ's disciples always.

**PEOPLE:** **This is the water of baptism. Out of this water we rise with new life, forgiven of sin and one in Christ, members in Christ's body.**

### SCRIPTURE READING

Mark 10:13-16 (responsively)

**LEADER:** They were bringing children to Jesus that he might touch them; and the disciples rebuked them. But when Jesus saw it, he was indignant and said to them:

**PEOPLE:** **"Let the children come to me, do not hinder them; for to such belongs the realm of God. Truly I say to you, whoever does not receive the realm of God like a child shall not enter it."**

**LEADER:** And Jesus took them in his arms and blessed them, laying his hands upon them.

- Will you participate regularly with Reagan in the worship, life, support, work, and mission of the church of Jesus Christ as it serves the community and the world? **We will.**
  
- And do you, Carly, and Paul who stand as godparents promise to support Reagan and her parents in the promises made this day? Do you promise to nurture this child as she explores the ways of God and as she grows in faith? **Godparents: We do.**

### AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

**LEADER:** As a sign of covenant with those baptized this day let us all join with those participating and with the church in all times and places in affirming our faith.

Do you believe in God the Source, the fountain of life? **I believe in God.**

Do you believe in Christ the Servant, embodied in Jesus of Nazareth and in the church? **I believe in Christ.**

Do you believe in the Spirit the Guide, the liberating wellspring of life? **I believe in the Spirit.**

### CONGREGATIONAL ASSENT

(responsively)

**LEADER:** Jesus calls us to make disciples of others, and to offer them the gift of grace in baptism. On behalf of the Christian Church in every place, do you who witness and celebrate this sacrament promise your love, support and care to Reagan as she lives and grows in Christ?

**PEOPLE:** **We promise our love, support, and care.**
