interpreted by love.

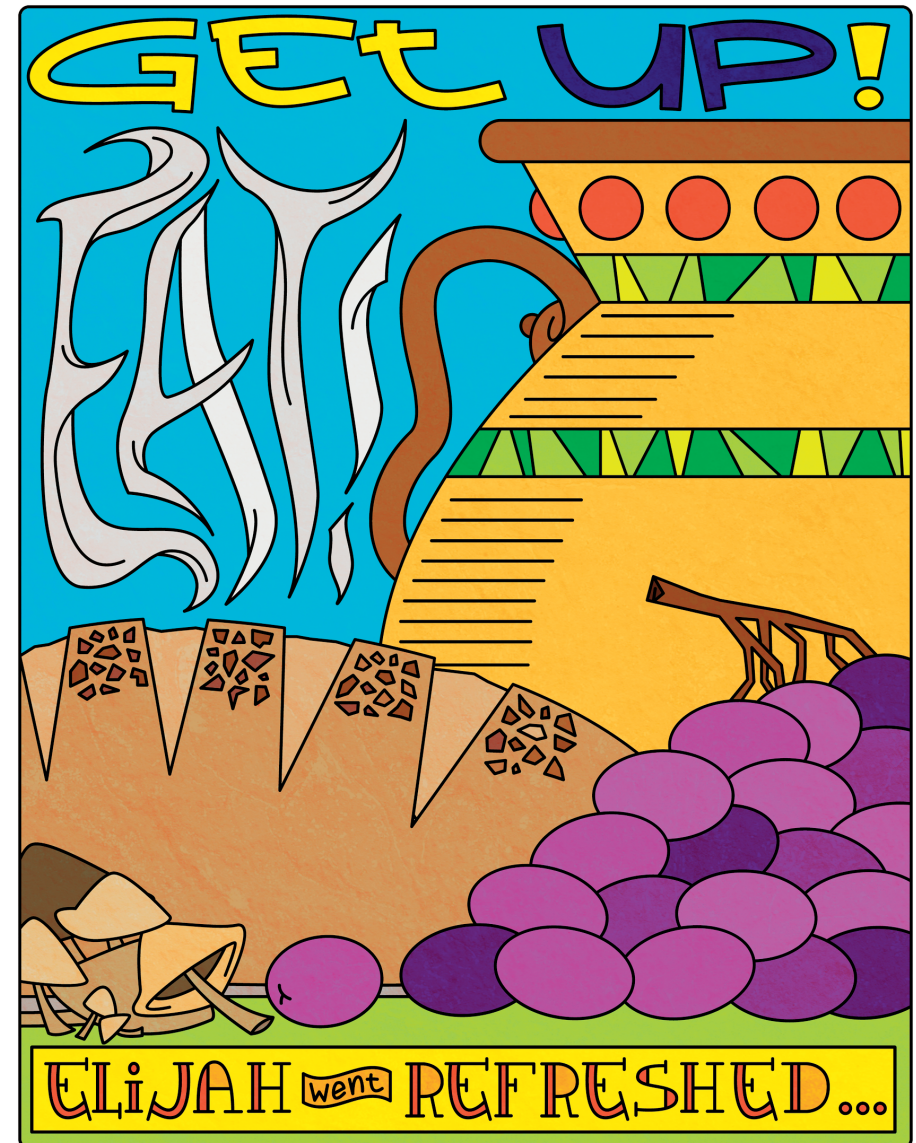
Drop your still dews of quietness,
