and share with them a glorious crown of gold.**

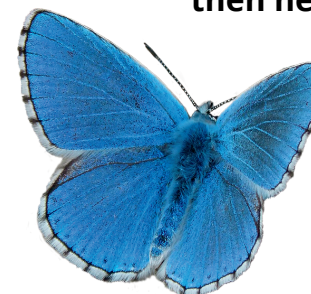
Alleluia! Alleluia!

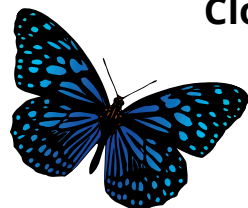
