CANDLE LIGHTING

The pastor will take the flame from the Christ Candle and offer it to the Deacons who will share the light with the congregation while they remain seated in the pews. As the persons on the end of the pew receives the flame, they will pass this on to their neighbors until all the candles are lit in the sanctuary. As the flame is passed everyone is invited to sing all four verse of Silent Night, Hymn #12 in the Booklet

John 1: 1-5 Rev. Tom Bentley (While the scripture is read everyone is requested to extinguish their candles. At the end of reading all the sanctuary is made dark save for the one flame in the Christ Candle.)
