Yesterday, Sunday, May 13th, was Confirmation Sunday, a Milestone Sunday. It was in that service that we celebrated *a milestone* in the life of seven people in our church: their Confirmation of Faith.

Actually, it is *a milestone* for all of us who are part of the ministry of Centre Congregational Church, United Church of Christ. It is a milestone if you have helped to make hospitable our spiritual community. Confirmation is a milestone for you if you support the ministry of Centre Church financially. Every act of giving and generosity is blessed by God for the sake of the ministry to which we have been called. Every gift is used by God to be a blessing in the life of someone.

I thank all of you for what you do to make such milestones possible! I thank you for your service, for your teaching, leading, your hospitality, your generous giving, your attendance so that our confirmands see and know that we stand and walk with them in their journeys of faith.

It is a sacred calling, what we do here, in

community, for the sake of God's will and work. It is not my will or your will, but God's will that we follow here. When Jesus says "Follow me" he is calling us to a change of direction, a greater meaning, a more important way of doing. It may include what we are already doing, but it will mean doing it for a different purpose that only God can see clearly.
