Summer Reading

Now that spring is finally springing and the Memorial Day weekend is behind us, I know our thoughts and hearts are turning toward the summer ahead and all we have planned. For many of us, that means lazier days, beach days, lake days, hiking, biking, and swimming days...and summer reading for adults and kids alike. So, I thought I'd share with you some of the titles I'm currently reading or hope to read over the summer months - interspersed with some great fiction, of course, because who doesn't need an opportunity to escape into another world, into someone else's story now and then?

I'm currently reading Barking to the Choir: The Power of Radical Kinship by Gregory Boyle. Father Greg Boyle is the founder of Homeboy Industries in Los Angeles, the largest gang-intervention, rehabilitation, and reentry program in the world. This is his second book, the first being Tattoos on the Heart: The Power of Boundless Compassion, which many of you may have already read. Both books will have you laughing, crying, and learning the deep truths of the power of compassion and kinship to redeem us all in the midst of our everyday lives.

I found Nora McInerny through her TED Talk on grief. I have begun listening to her podcast, "Terrible, Thanks for Asking." Her new book is No Happy Endings: A Memoir. I'm going to read No Happy Endings because I find Nora engaging and deep and funny and want to

hear more from her on life after life has fallen apart. Maybe you will, too!

In June the UCC will gather for General Synod 32 in Milwaukee, WI. This year the keynote speaker is author Matthew Desmond. In preparation for Synod, the UCC has suggested a denomination-wide read of Desmond's book, Evicted. I have had this book on my shelf for a few years because of a friend's recommendation. I am going to take it off the shelf and read it this summer. I believe it has the power to transform our thinking about eviction and poverty and how both affect our neighbors and our communities.

For children, Matthew Paul Turner, author of When God Made You has a new book out titled When I Pray For You. It is absolutely precious and perfect for our small ones, and even our "not-so-small" ones! I'm going to add both to my children's book collection. It would make a great gift for so many of life's milestone occasions.

There are others as the books on my bedside table, my office shelves, my Audible account, and my wish list are always piling up, up, up. I'm certain you all have many great books to recommend, too. I hope you'll send me a note or an email and tell me about the best reads you've enjoyed and learned from!
