World Communion Sunday

According to the website of the National Council of Churches, World Communion Sunday began in 1936 in the Presbyterian Church and was adopted by the Federal Council of Churches, a predecessor of the National Council of Churches in 1940. Since then, the celebration has grown into an international ecumenical celebration of Christian unity. Just as in 1936, the world feels very fractured today and it feels evermore important for us as Christians to come together around Christ's Table and remember who we are called to be, how we are called to act, and who it is that is calling us.

This year, as we look to the early church in the Acts of the Apostles for wisdom and truth to guide our life together, we recall that they gathered for the "breaking of the bread." Given the diversity of people and languages who heard the good news on the Day of Pentecost, and Jesus' call to the apostles to be his witnesses to the ends of the earth, World Communion Sunday serves as an intentional enacted reminder that every time we gather at Christ's table, we are united with believers not only across the globe but across time and beyond time.

Join us on Sunday, October 3 at 10:00 am, either in person or via livestream as we celebrate Holy Communion with believers all over the earth. As we break bread and share the cup with millions of God's people, we will recall that we are all God's beloved children, each one loved and claimed by our God, the One God, Creator, Christ, and Holy Spirit.
